

Spectator/Parent/Guardian Code of Conduct

A. In order to uphold the goals of Lincoln County Parks & Recreation and ensure that all participants have the benefit of a safe and fun learning environment, all parents, guardians and other adults and attendees of Lincoln County Parks & Recreation events, including but not limited to practices, competitions, and banquets, must behave accordingly in a respectful, courteous and sportsmanlike manner at all times.

B. Any spectator who is using alcohol or non-prescription drugs and/or appears intoxicated at a Lincoln County Parks & Recreation event, and/or who is flagrantly rude, attempts to intimidate, verbally abuse, heckles, taunts, ridicules, boos, throws objects and/or uses vulgarity or profane language/gestures with an official, coach, volunteer, staff member, participant or other event attendee, will be asked to leave a Lincoln County Parks & Recreation event. Any adult, who commits one of the above stated offenses and is ejected, will be banned from Lincoln County Parks & Recreational events for a period of the remainder of that sports season from the date of the offense, and their children may also be removed from the program(s) for that time period. There is no appeal process.

C. Any spectator who physically assaults an official, coach, volunteer, staff member or participant or threatens grave bodily harm will be banned from any and all Lincoln County Parks & Recreational events for the remainder of that sports season from the date of the offense, and their children may also be removed from any and all Lincoln County Parks & Recreation programs for that same period of time. After the ban has expired, if the individual commits another offense of the adult code of conduct, the individual will be permanently banned from any and all Lincoln County Parks & Recreational events and the individual's children may also be permanently removed from any and all Lincoln County Parks & Recreation programs. There is no appeal process.

D. Parents/Guardian must be present at all practices and games at ALL times. This is mandatory! We do not allow anyone to drop their child off. You must be present at the facility. This is for the safety of your child.
